**The Elk Mound Police Department is establishing a hiring list for Part Time Limited Term Employment Police Officers.** Minimum Standards for candidates wishing to apply for this position include being a United States Citizen at least 18 years of age, possessing a valid driver's license with a good driving record, be in good physical condition, have the ability to possess a firearm, possess a high school diploma or equivalent, possess a minimum of 60 college credits from an accredited higher education institution recognized by the United States Secretary of Education, will not hold any felony convictions or any domestic abuse-related convictions (or convictions of any other offense if committed in Wisconsin could be punished as a felony) unless the applicant has been granted an absolute and unconditional pardon, will have vision correctable to 20/20, will possess good verbal and written communication skills, will be able to react quickly and effectively to stressful situations, be able to work evening-nights-weekends and holidays in various Wisconsin weather conditions, have clear and concise speech, the ability to handle several tasks simultaneously, must be able to perform essential functions of this position including the ability to use all standard law enforcement equipment, and **must be law enforcement certified or certifiable with the Wisconsin Department of Justice.**

Preference will be granted to those candidates who have previous experience or are currently employed with a Wisconsin law enforcement agency. Before hire, successful candidates will complete oral interviews and pass background checks, medical screening, drug screening and psychological screening.

Pay will start at \$15.00 an hour, with the opportunity for up to 20 hours per week.
