## Dear Village Resident:

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the Village of Elk Mound and hope to provide you with some useful information.

There are two parks available for your use, "Village Park" south on HWY H or (S Holly Avenue) and Mound Hill Park north on HWY H or (N Holly Avenue). The Village Park pavilion is available to rent in the summer at a rate of \$100.00 a day.

The Colfax/Elk Mound Solid Waste & Recycling Center is located north on Hwy H, turn right at Elk Mound Drive. Permits are required and will be mailed to you each year by the end of December. If you need a replacement permit, they are available at the Village Clerk's office located at E206 Menomonie Street (Highway 12) for a small fee. Permits are also valid at the Colfax Center located at N9147 810<sup>th</sup> Street, Colfax. Garbage pick-up services are available through GFL Environmental Services: <a href="https://www.gflenv.com">www.gflenv.com</a>.

Voting is held at the Village Hall (E206 Menomonie Street). Polling hours are 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Upcoming election dates will be posted in the Village newsletter and on the website <a href="www.elkmound.org">www.elkmound.org</a>. You can register to vote at <a href="www.myvote.wi.gov">www.myvote.wi.gov</a> or at the Clerk/Treasurer's office at the Village Hall, you will need to bring along proof of residence.

If you own a dog, your dog will need to be licensed in the Village. Please call the clerk's office at 715-879-5011 to get more information on the licensing procedure.

With the proximity of the schools, there are a number of children using the sidewalk system to & from school. In the winter, please keep your sidewalks safe for the children and other pedestrians by keeping them free of snow and ice. Also, in the summer keep your lawn mowed/trimmed.

In the winter from November 1<sup>st</sup> through April 1<sup>st</sup>, even-odd street parking is in effect. From 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m., on odd-numbered calendar days, parking is allowed on that side of the street with odd-numbered house numerals; and on even-numbered calendar days, on that side of the street with even numbered house numerals.

If you plan to make structural changes, re-roof or reside your home, construct a new fence, etc. permits are required. Please call the Village Clerk's office 715-879-5011 to see if a permit is required for your specific project. This permit application can be obtained at the Village Clerk's office or on our website under forms.

Your property taxes can be paid at the Dunn County Treasurer's office, 3001 US Highway 12E, Suite 102A, Menomonie, WI 54751. Phone: 715-232-3789.

If you wish to receive a monthly newsletter by mail that provides the latest information on board meetings, public notices, etc. please call the Village Hall at 715-879-5011. This is always available on our website at <a href="https://www.elkmound.org">www.elkmound.org</a>. The Village Ordinances are also available on the website. If you are interested, there is a Village ordinance book available for your review at the Village Hall.

Emergency services are provided by the Elk Mound Police and Elk Mound Area Fire District. In case of an emergency, dial 911. For non-emergency communications, see enclosed Resource Guide for contact numbers.

If you recently purchased a home, please contact us to update water/sewer utility services. Billing or service questions can be directed to the Village Clerk at 715-879-5011. Off hours or emergency services call 715-556-4566. You may receive your utility bill by email by calling the Village Clerk. A payment box is located at the front of the Village Hall for your convenience.

Annual activities include the Elk Mound Area Thrift Sale (sponsored by the Elk Mound Lions Club) normally held the first Friday and Saturday in June. Trick or Treating is on October 31<sup>st</sup> from 5:00pm to 7:00pm.

Elk Mound Post Office is located at E200 Menomonie Street (Hwy 12). Their hours of operation are Monday through Friday 8:30am – 11:30am, 12:30pm – 4:00pm, Saturday 8:30am – 9:45am, closed on Sundays. Their phone is 715-879-5365.

The Elk Mound Library is open Monday, Wednesday & Friday from 2:00pm to 6:00pm. They have three computers available for public use, and wifi is available to use with your personal devices. Elk Mound Library is a subsidiary of the Menomonie Public Library and a member of the MORE Library System.

The Community Center is available to rent for events, maximum occupancy is 45 persons.
