Report from Fire Board Representative

There were seven calls for service this month. Two new members were added to the roster.

Fire Inspector Larry Zais will begin performing more inspections. The Fire Board is still working with Chief Fuester on an ordinance for billing for fires.

Colfax EMS has placed an ambulance at the Elk Mound Fire Station. Stantec Consulting has requested records for the Elk Creek solar project area.

Reimbursement was received for the grant to purchase foam and the AED. Squad 2 was sold for \$17,277. Engine 5 broke a valve linkage that has been repaired. Chief Fuester is working with different endors to complete other major repairs on Engine 5. Tender 15 and Engine 6 need frame repair due to corrosion.

One of the furnaces at the Fire Station needs replacement. The water fountain at the Fire Station needs repair or possible replacement.

Report from Elk Mound/Colfax Solid Waste & Recycling

The unit is asking residents who want to dispose of unused medications to give them to the site attendants for proper disposal. Unwanted eyeglasses should also be given to the attendants so they can be repurposed for people who could use them.

There are two separate locations for yard waste and brush at each site for disposal. Residents are asked to properly separate these items when brought to the sites.

Colfax Rescue Squad Monthly Report

The Colfax Rescue Squad Monthly Report from February was reviewed. This is available in the Village Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

Community Center/Library Report

Terry Stamm reported that the Community Center/Library Board did not meet, but is scheduled to meet on March 25 at 4:30 p.m.

Clerk/Treasurer Karin Wolf will draft the letter.
