**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 3**

**A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE EFFORTS OF THE ELK MOUND POLICE  
AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS DURING THE RESIDENTIAL FIRE ON JUNIPER  
AVENUE IN SEPTEMBER 2024.**

**WHEREAS**, on September 4, 2024, there was a house fire on Juniper Avenue in the Village of Elk Mound, Dunn County, Wisconsin (the "Village").

**WHEREAS**, Police Chief Chad Weinberger ("Chief Weinberger") of the Elk Mound Police Department went to exceptional lengths to ensure the safety of the individuals in the home, including attempting to locate fire mitigation tools, responding to the residence immediately upon learning of the fire, informing dispatch of the fire, assisting the Elk Mound Fire Department, and alerting the individuals inside the residence to ensure they were evacuated to safety.

**WHEREAS**, Elk Mound Police Officer Kyle Devries responded to the fire while he was off duty and provided assistance by re-directing traffic and otherwise assisting the Elk Mound Police Department.


**WHEREAS**, the Elk Mound Fire Department responded quickly and efficiently worked to mitigate the damages of the fire.


**WHEREAS**, the efforts of Chief Weinberger, Police Officer Kyle Devries, and the Elk Mound Fire Department resulted in the safe evacuation of all residents who were inside the home at the time of the fire and aided in providing a quick response to the emergency.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Board of the Village of Elk Mound formally acknowledges and extends its profound appreciation to the Elk Mound Police and Fire Departments for their heroic efforts in saving the individuals who were in the house during the fire and attempting to mitigate the damages.

Adopted by the Village Board on October 21, 2024, by a vote of 6 yes and 0 no.
