ORDINANCE No. <u>2024-4</u>

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE REPEAL OF ZONING STATUTORY PROTEST PROVISIONS

The Village Board of the Village of Elk Mound, Dunn County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION I. ADOPTION OF PROVISIONS.

Section 13-1-243 of the Village of Elk Mound Code of Ordinances is repealed and recreated to read as follows:

Sec. 13-1-243 Zoning Statutory Protests.

With the repeal of Sec. 62.23(7)(d)2m.a, Wis. Stats., [effective January 1, 2025] zoning statutory protests are no longer permitted. Per Sec. 66.10015(3)(a), Wis. Stats., any Zoning Code amendment only requires approval by a simple majority of a quorum of the members-elect of the Village Board. However, a two-thirds vote remains required for a down zoning ordinance per Sec. 66.10015(3)(b), Wis. Stats., and for a zoning amendment when an airport protest petition if filed with the Village under Sec. 62.23(7)(d)2m, Wis. Stats.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional or if the application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provisions or applications.

SECTION III. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect on December 31, 2024, upon passage and publication/legal posting as provided by law.
